



Urban Operating System

A common platform that improves city efficiency and enables the provision of innovative mobile services and interconnectivity to businesses and individuals: an integrated city model.

Public security

Mobile services to enhance efficiency and offer new added-value functionalities to law enforcement agencies.

Infrastructures

Assistance in managing and controlling public infrastructures (street lights, road signs, etc.) and building management by the use of mobile technology.

Urban mobility

Intelligent fleet logistics: mobile tracking and intelligent routing that helps to reduce journey times, optimize cargo loading and improve the deployment of fleets.

mGovernment

Use of mobile technology and communications in services for government and individuals.

mEnergy

A mobile energy management service which helps users and utility companies manage consumption while improving efficiency.
