


# Wireless, M2M-based digital health solutions are opening new possibilities.

**41%** increase in health information exchange between hospitals and other providers between 2008 and 2012 (1)

- 66% of doctors use iPads or tablets for medical purposes (2)
- **75%** of providers report that electronic health records allow them to deliver better care <sup>(3)</sup>
- 10% of hospitals implemented data analytics tools in 2011, 50% are predicted to do so by 2016  $_{\scriptscriptstyle (4)}$


