Monitor Network Security

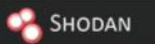
Keep track of all the computers on your network that are directly accessible from the Internet. Shodan lets you understand your digital footprint.

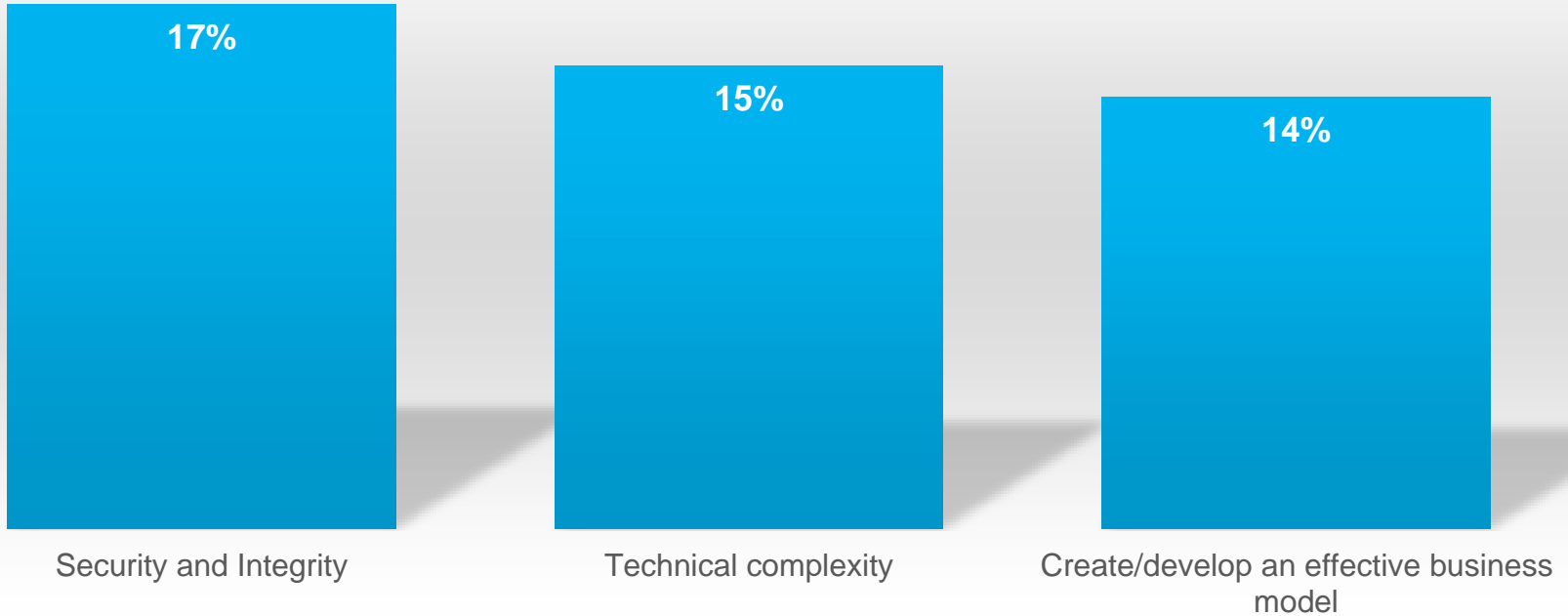

Security Challenges

Too many build unique and proprietary solutions

- Belief in security by obscurity
- Customer lock-in
- Harder to use the IoT ecosystem

New and often immature technologies are being used

- Flaws in 3rd party HW and SW
- Updates might break the design
- Sudden stop in future updates

Time to market often trumps security and quality

- Hacked shortly after launch
- More expensive to fix afterwards
- Brand damage takes time to heal

Lifecycle Management is not mature enough, or is simply missing

- Risk are not treated properly
- Poor design decisions
- Post-launch patching?


Existing best practices and frameworks are not being used or considered

- Mistakes are repeated
- OWASP top 5 has not changed, at least not much over the years

There is a shortage of security professionals

- Lack of skills and expertise
- Supply and demand
- Slow progress
