**1. GSMA Antitrust Policy and Agenda**

GSMA Anti-trust and US entity list stated were noted.

**2. OPG#86 Meeting minutes**

No comments were made.

**3. MWC Las Vegas Release Planning**

Tom presented the planning and status of the MWC Las Vegas release. An owner has been assigned for Topic J (Optare Solutions) and Topic S has been brought forward because no party volunteered as owner for topic H.

**4. CN0002 Topic E- Cellular Service continuity**

Deepak presented the initial version of the Concept Note for Topic E. Several comments were made requiring updates and clarifications in the next revision, among others:

- May have to differentiate between 4G and 5G core networks which are both in the scope of the PRD
- For non-3GPP access there is no control over the access network that can be used for providing QoS, even if QoS can be supported still in the packet core network and on the edge access network
- It is covering a very complex area and where likely there's no support to cover for all scenarios. So there will have to be application-level support to guarantee a proper UX in those circumstances. That support could be an enabler to keep complexity down for the OP in some of the other cases.
- A 5G device's support for ATSSS and Multiple PDU sessions could be useful tools in this context.
- Roaming should be kept out of scope to keep focus. There was a dedicated topic on that that hasn't been prioritised and also dependencies on networks supporting handovers at their boundaries.

Next OPG call (OPG#88) will be on 26<sup>th</sup> April. Concept notes for discussion in OPG#88 should be available by 21<sup>st</sup> April.
