Infrastructure Development


POLICY DIRECTION:

Income Tax Facility


- Tax Holiday
- Tax Allowance
- Reduction of import income tax
 Super Deduction for R&D and vocational training

Customs & Excise Facilities

- Exemption from import duty for "KITE" capital goods
 - Bonded Storage Area
- Import duties are borne by the government

Value-Added Tax Facility

- VAT Reduction:
 - Capital goods
- Health and Education Services
 - Social Services
 - Export services



Special Facility

- Facilities in Special Economic Zones (KEK)
- Facilities in industrial areas
- Free Trade Zone

Super Deduction Labour-Intensive (pipeline)

Encouraging the Role of Private Sector in Labor Intensive Investment

Omnibus Law (pipeline)

Encourage investment and the business sector through reducing corporate income tax rates
