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## **1. GSMA Antitrust Policy and Agenda**

GSMA Anti-trust and US entity list statement were noted.

The agenda for the meeting was approved. Elisabeth has informed that CR0007R1 (OPG\_134\_Doc\_03) is work in progress and not ready to be discussed. It was agreed to skip the corresponding topic in the agenda.

## **2. OPG#133 Meeting minutes**

No comments were made.

Minutes of OPG#133 were approved.

## **3. Action Points**

Action points were reviewed. The only action that is not closed is on hold till the end of the MWC Las Vegas release and can thus not be closed.

## **4. OPG MWC Las Vegas Release planning**

Tom presented the planning for the OP MWC Las Vegas 23 release highlighting that based on the requirements for approval defined in AA.35 the CR deadline for OPG could be shifted by a week and the one for OPAG by 2 weeks allowing more time to finalise the topic CRs.

Because even with the shifted CR deadlines it did not seem realistic to finalise the SBI-OAM document in OPAG in time to meet those, the publication of that document was deferred to the MWC Barcelona 24 release.

## **5. Enhanced Charging**

OPG\_134\_Doc\_03\_CR0007R1 was skipped because the CR was not ready to be discussed.

Mario presented OPG\_134\_Doc\_04\_CR0008R2, updating the proposed annex on enhanced charging. Following comments were made:

- The title should refer to the annex covering "charging concepts" or similar because its contents are not defining the charging itself.
- The example on how to introduce gradually more complex charging concepts should be reviewed by anti-trust specialists.

**Action:** Tom to provide CR0008R2 to a GSMA anti-trust specialist for review.

## 6. EDGEAPP and OP Mapping

Tom presented OPG\_134\_Doc\_05 (CR0009R1) proposing to remove the detailed mapping of ETSI ISG MEC, 3GPP EDGEAPP and OP from the annex of OPG.02 as discussed in OPG#132 and OPG#133. The following comments were made:

- The figure in section A.1.1 should be deleted as well.

There were no objections against approving CR0009 with that update.

CR0009R2 was approved.

## 7. E2E Use Cases

Tom presented OPG\_134\_Doc\_06 (CR0010) proposing updates to the backlog following the whiteboard discussion in OPG#126 and the discussion of CN0006 in OPG#133. No comments were made.

Given the limited number of changes and that the CR had been available for 1,5 days already, there were no objections against handling the approval CR0010 in the meeting rather than deferring the approval to an offline approval or to OPG#135. There were no objections against approving CR0010.

CR0010 was approved.

## 8. AOB

The OPG maintenance CR on the security sections (i.e. CR0001R4) will be reviewed by the Fraud and Security Architecture Group. OPG members are requested to inform their counterparts in that group.

OPG#135 will take place on 23<sup>rd</sup> May as a virtual meeting.
