Arriving at the Main Entrance

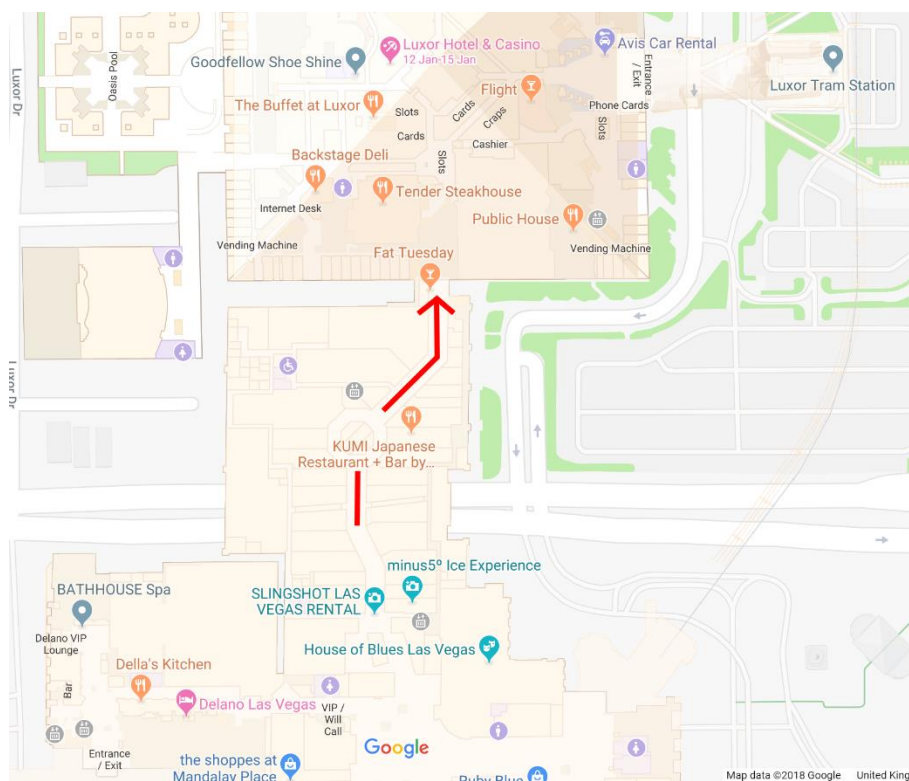
(Via tram or taxi at the main valet)

- After entering the Luxor at the main entrance, head right towards the Front Desk
- Walk past the front desk towards the East Tower on the right
- Follow the path to the Galleria Square meeting space on your left
- Lotus Ballroom 1 & 2 are on the right-hand side of the Convention Centre



Arriving via the Mandalay Bay Walkway

- After entering Luxor from Mandalay Bay Place walkway, take the escalators down to the Casino level
