Although data generation is performed by CTWY Shenzhen, the data generation platform is provided, developed, configured and managed by the customers. CTWY Shenzhen is not SAS-UP certified to operate any other data generation mechanism or to manage encryption keys. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic travel restrictions the audit was performed remotely in accordance with the GSMA SAS Covid-19 Audit and Certification Policy. An assessment of compliance with requirements that could not be audited fully remotely will need to be performed as part of a follow-up physical audit after Covid-19 related disruption to on-site SAS audits has ended.
