The customer organisation acts as a technology partner, supplying SecureID with tools for data generation & production management. Although encryption keys are used to protect production data & customer response files, mechanisms for management & use of these keys were setup by the customer organisation at the installation of the system. SecureID has not demonstrated any of processes or controls for key management as part of the SAS-UP certification process.
